

Special Rules for the Gauja and Brasla River

From 1 January to 30 April, licensed fishing for salmonids is in force in the Gauja and Brasla rivers. This is carried out in accordance with Binding Regulations No. 50 of the Cēsis Municipality Council.

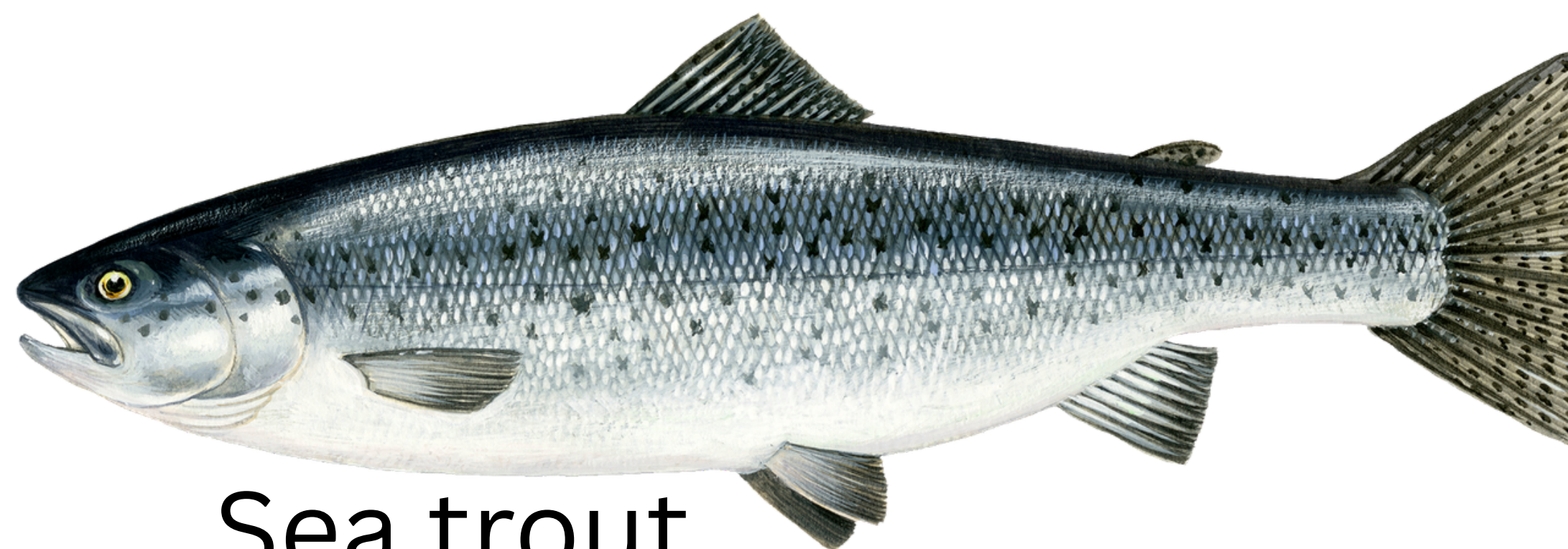

At other times, fishing is permitted in accordance with the general fishing regulations.

If you are planning to fish in the Gauja or Brasla **between 1 January and 30 April**, please note the following:

- **A day licence is mandatory:** If you are using a **spinning rod** or **fly fishing rod** (with artificial bait/lures), a licence is required even if you are not specifically targeting sea trout or any other salmonid species. For fishing with natural bait (worms, etc.), no licence is required.
- **Catch limit:** You may keep **one sea trout** measuring **50–70 cm**. As soon as the fish has been retained, the licence is no longer valid and fishing must be stopped.
- **Protect salmon:** It is strictly forbidden to retain salmon in your catch.
- **Reporting:** Within **5 days** after fishing, do not forget to register your catch at manacope.lv (even if nothing was caught).
